To Be + number + years old

- I **am** 23 years old.
- **You are** 16 years old.
- **He is** 32 years old.
- **Mary is** 45 years old.

Years old is optional.

You can say:

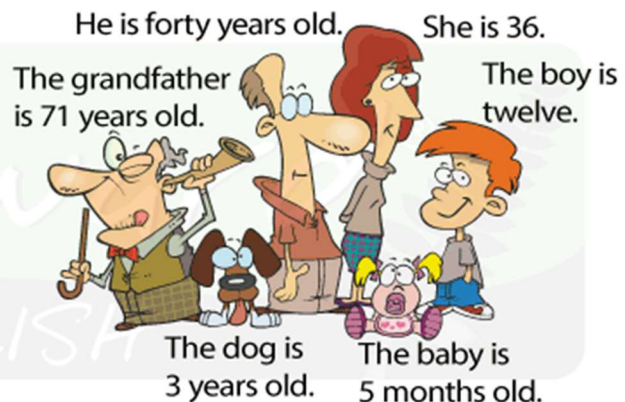
- I am 18 **years old**. **OR**
- I am 18.

BUT... *years + old*
are always together

- I am 21. ✓
- I am 21 years. ✗
- I am 21 years old. ✓

You can write the age as
numbers or as words.

- I am **12** years old.
- I am **twelve** years old.



With babies, you can use
months instead of **years**.

- The baby is 4 **months** old.
- She is nine **months** old.

Be Careful - In English we use the
verb **TO BE** and not another verb.

- I have 18. ✗
- I **am** 18. ✓
- I have 18 years. ✗
- I have 18 years old. ✗
- I **am** 18 years old. ✓

The Question: **How old are you?** - I'm _____ years old.
