- fall the season after summer and before winter
- autumn another word for fall (this word is less common and more formal; use "fall" in conversation)
- chilly a little cold
- to get to become (Example: The days get shorter, the nights get longer)
- frost a thin layer of ice
- foliage leaves
- maple / oak / ginkgo / pine types of trees
- bare with nothing covering it / naked (Example: The trees are bare.)
- nut a dry edible fruit in a hard shell, such as peanuts, walnuts, etc.
- acorn the nut of an oak tree
- chestnut the nut of a chestnut tree, often roasted and eaten in fall and winter
- harvest to gather a crop
- crops food that farmers grow
- ripe ready to gather or eat (Example: The banana is yellow. It is ripe.)
- Thanksgiving one of the most important holidays in the U.S., a day of feasting celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November
- Halloween a holiday celebrated October 31st, where people dress up in costumes and children go door-to-door asking for candy
