

# Fall Vocabulary

- **fall** - the season after summer and before winter
- **autumn** - another word for fall (this word is less common and more formal; use “fall” in conversation)
- **chilly** - a little cold
- **to get** - to become (Example: The days get shorter, the nights get longer)
- **frost** - a thin layer of ice
- **foliage** - leaves
- **maple / oak / ginkgo / pine** - types of trees
- **bare** - with nothing covering it / naked (Example: The trees are bare.)
- **nut** - a dry edible fruit in a hard shell, such as peanuts, walnuts, etc.
- **acorn** - the nut of an oak tree
- **chestnut** - the nut of a chestnut tree, often roasted and eaten in fall and winter
- **harvest** - to gather a crop
- **crops** - food that farmers grow
- **ripe** - ready to gather or eat (Example: The banana is yellow. It is ripe.)
- **Thanksgiving** - one of the most important holidays in the U.S., a day of feasting celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November
- **Halloween** - a holiday celebrated October 31st, where people dress up in costumes and children go door-to-door asking for candy
