

## Beginner Week 7 Vocabulary Present Progressive Tense





Use the present progressive tense to talk about something that a person is doing **now**.







For the present progressive tense, use:  
**a form of "to be" (am, is, are) + a verb ending in "-ing"**

Example:

Simple present tense: I **wash** the dishes every night.

Present progressive tense: I **am washing** the dishes right now.

Verb	Present Progressive Tense	Question	Answer
Do	Doing	What are they doing?	 <p>They <b>are doing</b> their homework.</p>
Cook	Cooking	What is he doing?	 <p>He <b>is cooking</b> spaghetti.</p>
Drink	Drinking	What is she doing?	 <p>She <b>is drinking</b> water.</p>
Eat	Eating	What is he doing?	 <p>He <b>is eating</b> cereal.</p>

Hold	Holding	What is she doing?	 <p>She <b>is holding</b> the baby.</p>
Bake	Baking	What is she doing?	 <p>She <b>is baking</b> cookies.</p>
Read	Reading	What is she doing?	 <p>She <b>is reading</b> a book.</p>
Wear	Wearing	What is he doing?	 <p>He <b>is wearing</b> a mask.</p>
Fix	Fixing	What is he doing?	 <p>He <b>is fixing</b> his bike.</p>
Study	Studying	What are they doing?	 <p>They <b>are learning</b> English.</p>

Play	Playing	What is she doing?	 <p data-bbox="1075 415 1377 451">She <i>is playing</i> soccer.</p>
