Examples:

IN -

School begins in September.

I was born in 1995.

There will be a presidential election in 2020.

In the summertime, I love to go swimming.

Thanksgiving happens in the fall.

I need to drink coffee in the morning.

A lot of good music came out in the 70s.

Class starts in ten minutes.

We haven't seen each other in three years.

AT -

Bats are awake at night.

I went to bed at 11 o'clock.

The class starts at 7.

They went hiking at sunrise.

ON -

On Thursday night, we have English class.

I'm going to see my family on Thanksgiving.

Her flight leaves on October 3rd.

I sleep in late on the weekend.
